



Jack Pearsall Memorial Soccer Scholarship

Deadline: Friday, April 3, 2020

The Jack Pearsall Memorial Soccer Scholarship was created to remember and honor Jack Pearsall, a 16- year-old Falmouth boy who was struck and killed by a drunk driver in July 2011. Jack's PACT was then established for him as well. Jack was an energetic, enthusiastic, extremely competitive athlete who loved soccer more than anything else. He began kicking the ball around as soon as he learned to walk. As a teen, he got involved in coaching, refereeing, and volunteering for younger "Rec" teams, as well as playing himself.

The purpose of the JP Memorial Soccer Scholarship is to help students with post-graduation goals who demonstrate their passion for soccer, like Jack, and live by their Jack's PACT pledges: "I pledge not to drive while under the influence of drugs or alcohol and encourage others to do the same." This scholarship may be used as financial assistance for furthering education, traveling for community service, or other forms of self-discovery after graduation.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicants must have already signed Jack's PACT and uphold this pledge every day.
- Applicants must have volunteered with Jack's PACT or participated in Run Jack Run.
- Applicants must be graduating seniors who are Falmouth residents that have played soccer in an organized fashion for at least 2 of the last 4 years.

FOR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS TO KNOW:

- In selecting recipients, the JP Scholarship Committee will take into account your involvement in Jack's PACT, financial need, academic merit, and the importance of soccer in your own life.
- If a recipient accepts an award and later changes their post-graduation plans as indicated, they must contact the Committee with their change of plans as soon as possible.
- All recipients should plan to attend (walk, run, volunteer, or cheer!) our 9th Annual Run Jack Run Family Fun Run/Walk on July 4, 2020. This is a fundraiser for this scholarship in memory of Jack. A brief Awards Celebration for recipients will take place at the finish at Trotting Park.
